Kanji notation, Yamazakura. It is a wild species distributed in Honshu, Shikoku, Kyushu and the Korean Peninsula.

There is a feature that the underside of mature leaves of mature trees becomes whitish. Cherry blossoms have been an object of appreciation since ancient times, and Mt. Yoshino in Nara is still a famous scenic spot.
